This interface connects an iPod (includes iTouch, and iPhone) directly to Lexus /Toyota car audio systems. Its on-board software translates commands from the CD changer controls or SAT controls into commands that the iPod understands. This interface provides the following benefits:

- Directs the iPod's audio output to Lexus or Toyota vehicle audio system for optimal sound quality playback.
- Controls the iPod via car radio and steering wheel controls.
- Charges the iPod's internal battery and charging stops automatically half an hour after iPod is paused. iPod goes to sleep mode when charging stops.

# Section 6. Playlist Naming

# **Playlist naming**

 When iPod is connected to your radio via the PA15-TOY interface adapter, the adapter scans all available Playlists on iPod and looks for designated Toyota Playlists which are created for direct access with the DISC controls on Toyota radios. The designated Toyota Playlists are related to DISC numbers in the following manner:

DISC 1: TOYOTA1...
DISC 2: TOYOTA2...
DISC 3: TOYOTA3...
DISC 4: TOYOTA4...
DISC 5: TOYOTA5...
DISC 6: TOYOTA6...
DISC 7: ALL SONGS on iPod...

The naming of designated Toyota Playlists in iTune for PA15-TOY interface must be exactly as shown. Toyota must be in capital letters and there can not be any spaces between the word Toyota and the number.

However, you may add any text after the correct naming of a Playlist. (i.e. TOYOTA1-Jazz, TOYOTA3\_Favorite3 are acceptable Playlist names for the PA15-TOY iPod interface.)

- If no designated Toyota playlists are created, then the PA15-TOY adapter will automatically relate the first six Playlists on iPod to DISC # 1 to #6 regardless of Playlist names.
- If less than six designated Toyota Playlists are created, then the PA15-TOY adapter
  will automatically fill up the rest of the DISC numbers with the first available
  Playlists on iPod. For example: if only three designated TOYOTA1, TOYOTA3
  and TOYOTA 5 Playlists are created, then the disc numbers on the radio will be:

DISC 1: TOYOTA1...

DISC 2:(1st available Playlist on iPod)

DISC 3: TOYOTA3...

DISC 4: (2<sup>nd</sup>available Playlist on iPod)

DISC 5: TOYOTA5...

DISC 6: (3<sup>rd</sup> availabe Playlist on iPod)

The iPod interface does not recognize Playlists that do not contain audio tracks regardless of Playlist naming. The iPod interface also does not recognize the "On-The-Go" Playlist on your iPod.

# Compatibility

This interface is capable of retaining factory SAT receiver, in dash CD player and in dash CD changer.

### **Package Contents**

This package contains one each of the following: PA15-TOY interface adaptor, CAS-TY, CAS-TA, and CB-PA105 cables.

\* If your vehicle has a factory XM receiver and you wish to use the SAT control configuration then you need to purchase a separate cable: part # CAS-SAT. Please call 626 336 3836 to purchase any additional or replacement accessories.

## **Text Display of Song information**

Artist name and song title can be displayed on radios equipped with either a "TEXT" button or a "TITLE" touch key on navigation screen. Text display is supported in Playlist Mode only. Track search by artist, song title or album from radio is NOT supported

# Section 2. Direct Mode, Playlist Mode,

# and AUX Option

PA15-TOY provides two ways to control and access music on iPod from the car stereo, namely, Playlist Mode and Direct Mode.

#### 2-1 Direct Mode

Search and select music on iPod just as you would in portable use and iPod buttons are fully functional at all times. You can also change tracks, fast forward, and fast reverse from the radio and the steering wheel control.

- Direct Mode is supported in both SAT control and CD changer control configuration.
- When PA15-TOY is configured to CD changer control, DISC#8 is dedicated to Direct Mode.
- When PA15-TOY is configured to SAT control, SAT1-8ch is dedicated to Direct Mode
- No text display on radio while in Direct Mode.

# ♦ Application Tip

Direct Mode allows for the playing of free wi-fi music streaming such as pandora.com® from your iPhone or iTouch through the car stereo systems.

# 2-2 Playlist Mode

Operate and control the iPod like it is a CD changer. This mode allows you to access five Playlists on iPod from radio. iPod screen always displays "OK to disconnect" or "Accessory Connected" and iPod's keypad is locked and not functional. See section 3 of this manual for additional information.

- Playlist Mode is supported in both SAT control configuration and CD changer control configuration.
- When PA15-TOY is configured to use CD changer control, DISC #1 to DISC #6 are Playlists, and DISC #7 is All Songs on iPod.
- When PA15-TOY is configured to use SAT control, SAT1-1ch to SAT1-6ch are Playlists, and SAT1-7ch is All Songs.
- If your iPod has more than 6 Playlists, see Playlist Naming in Section 6 of this manual

### 2-3 RCAAUX INPUT

Besides iPod, PA15-TOY can also connect a second audio source to the RCA jack labeled AUX INPUT. AUX input is enabled by setting the DIP switch #1 on the side of this adaptor to ON position. When radio is in CD mode, AUX input is accessed at CD9-1 or SAT1-9ch.

# **Section 3.** Function, Control, and iPod Connection

# 3-1 When Using CD Changer Control Configuration

# 3-1-1 DIP Switch Setting

Please see the chart in Section 4 for your vehicle's DIP switch setting guide.

## 3-1-2 Functions and Radio Buttons

Press CD button on radio to access iPod.

Use DISC ▲ or DISC ▼ buttons on radio to access Playlist, Direct Mode, and RCA AUX as follow: (Note: Some Toyota radios do not have DISC UP and DISC DOWN buttons on the radio. The Track +/- button on the steering wheel should be pressed and held to perform DISC Up / DOWN function.)



# **Section 5. Wire Connection**

- Step 1- Remove radio from the dash.
- Step 2- Plug the round din plug of the CAS-TY to PA15-TOY interface adapter box where it is labeled "RADIO".
- Step 3- Plug the other end of CAS-TY cable to the receptor at the back of the radio. (For recent year models, plug CAS-TA to the back of the radio and connect CAS-TY to the other end of CAS-TA.)
- Step 4-a- Connect the audio output of your auxiliary devices to AUX input jack on PA15-TOY adapter box if the additional AUX option is selected by setting the DIP switch #1 to "ON" position.
- Step 4-b- Set the DIP switch #2, #3 and #4 according to the table in Section 2-5.
- Step 5- Plug CB-PA105 cable to PA15-TOY adaptor box where it is labeled "iPod"
- Step 6- Reinstall the radio to the dash.

#### **WARNING!!**

Use only the iPod connection cable which comes with PA15-TOY interface adaptor. iPod Connection cables from other sources may look similar, but they may damage your iPod.

If PA15-TOY conflicts with CD chager or can not be recognized by the radio, then set the DIP swithches as followed: DIP #2: OFF; DIP #4 = ON; DIP #4 =

NOTE: (1) ON. If "B" type configuration also does not work then set the DIP swithces to "C" type configuration: DIP #2 = OFF; DIP #3= OFF; DIP#4 = ON. In type "C", radio gives 6 DISCs only and DISC #6 is Direct Mode if AUX (DIP #1) is OFF; DISC #5 is Direct Mode if AUX (DIP #1) is ON.

NOTE: (2) In 2001 model vehicles the built in CDC may not be operable while iPod is connected to PA15-TOY

NOTE: (3) 98 - 02 Sienna requires adaptor cable CAS-TLC to retain steering wheel control

NOTE: (4) Adaptor cable CAS-SAT is required if the vehicles has factory SAT receiver

NOTE: (5) 01-04 Land Cruiser requries adaptor cable CAS-TLC

NOTE: (6) 01-03 vehicles requries adaptor cable CAS-LEX

Non-Nav vehicles requires CAS-TLC adoptor cable. Vehicles must have NOTE: (7) external CD changer. Must disconnect the CD changer and connect the CAS-TLC cable. Nav vehicles requires CAS-LEX cable.

If the following vehicles have Rear Seat Entertainment then connect PA15-TOY at ECU: 4Runner 05 & older, Highlander 06 & older, Sienna 05 & older and Lexus GX470/RX330 06 & older: **ECU in passenger side rear quarter panel**. Tundra 06 & older and Sequoia 07 & older: **ECU in center console**.

NOTE: (9) Some 2010-11 radios may not support the TEXT display for iPod adapter.

# 3-1-3 Connecting and Playing iPod

- When iPod is connected to interface adaptor and CD button is pressed, iPod will play at DISC #7.
- DISC #7 will continue to play the track in *the* Folder which was played prior to the iPod being connected to the PA15-TOY. When the last track of *the* Folder is played, iPod will go to the first track of All Songs on the iPod.
- When returning to DISC #7 from Direct Mode (DISC #8), DISC #7 will continue
  the track and the folder that was being played at DISC #8 (Direct Mode). When
  the last track of *the* Folder is played, iPod will go to All Songs on the iPod.
- If iPod has more than 6 Playlists, then please see section 6 for instructions on how to name the Playlists.

# 3-2 When Using SAT Control Configuration

# 3-2-1 DIP Switch Setting

Please see the chart in Section 4 for your vehicle's DIP switch setting guide.

#### 3-2-2 Functions and Radio Buttons

- Press SAT button on radio to access iPod SAT1.
- Press SAT button on radio to access SAT stations at SAT2 and SAT3.
- For Avalon radios, press ◀ and ▶ buttons to change Playlist and to access DIRECT MODE.

For **TUNDRA and other car model** radios, press DISC  $(\land, \lor)$  to change playlist and to access DIRECT MODE.

 Push TEXT button on radio to view music's text information. Text display on the radio is as follow: (Note: available on SAT ready radio only)

TEXT Button	Text from iPod	Note
1st Push →	Playlist number and Track number	(a)
2nd Push→	Song Title	
3rd Push →	Artist name	
4th Push →	Playlist Name	

- Press TRACK (or SEEK) or turn the TUNING knob to change track. Note (a): Due to the radio's limit on maximun SAT channel number is 255, the far left hand digit of track number display is therefore reset to 0 (zero) at every integer multiple of 256. For example, the 256th track on iPod is displayed as 056 and the 456th track on iPod is also displayed as 056.
- Press RDN button to begin the RANDOM track play and press RDN button 2<sup>nd</sup> time to terminate the RANDOM play.
- For Avalon radios, press the preset #1 or the preset #2 buttons to retreat or advance 10 tracks respectively.
  - For **TUNDRA** and other car model radios, press preset ◀◀and ▶▶ to retreat or advance 10 tracks respectively.
- Press SCAN button to advance 10 tracks when random is OFF.

# 3-2-3 Connecting and Playing iPod

- When iPod is connected to the interface adaptor and the SAT button on radio is pressed then iPod will begin to play at SAT1-7ch (All Songs on iPod).
   SAT1-7ch will continue to play the track in *the* Folder which was played prior iPod is connected to PA15-TOY. When the last track of *the* Folder is played, iPod will go to the first track of All Songs folder.
- When returning to SAT1-7ch from Direct Mode (SAT1-8ch), SAT1-7ch will continue
  the track and the folder that was being played at SAT1-8ch (Direct Mode). When the
  last track of *the* folder is played, iPod will go to All Songs folder.
- If iPod has more than 6 Playlists, then please see section 6 of this manual for Playlist Naming instructions.
